OPERATION SIEGE

During times of economic downturn, theft offences increase. 2022 has seen a rise in burglary offences along the Chalke Valley area Wiltshire Police, under **Operation Siege**, have partnered with **SelectaDNA** to provide an affordable crime prevention tool that can be used to mark all valuables (except paper and fabric), which can be used both indoors and outdoors and is guaranteed for 5 years (if kept out of direct sunlight).

Trials in other parts of the country have seen a reduction in burglary offences of up to 83%. The operation provides both a visible deterrent as well as an invisible marking which confirms ownership. Thieves will avoid stealing marked property as it becomes difficult to sell on.

Each SelectaDNA Home Kit includes:

- 8ml bottle of SelectaDNA. This is sufficient to mark 50 items of property. It is a superglue, applied by a simple applicator and once dry is almost impossible to remove without causing damage. It contains:
 - o **UV Tracer** under UV light it will glow Blue
 - Synthetic DNA this liquid is unique and registered to the single owner. SelectaDNA provide a free service to the Police to identify the owner.
 - Microdots 1000's of tiny discs that contain the unique code to that bottle, which under a microscope can help to identify the owner (see photo)
- **50 Tamper Resistant Stickers** to apply to marked items. These will shred if you try to peel and leave a glue sludge which is hard to remove.
- 4 Window Stickers These add an additional deterrent when applied to points of entry at the front and rear of the property.
- Instruction Leaflet Clear and simple instructions on how to apply. It is a very simple process.
- **Lifetime Membership of the Secure Asset Register (SAR)** This is a secure register of up to 50 items, all registered to the owner, using the unique code from the bottle of SelectaDNA. The SAR records:
 - o Your Contact Details Name, address, telephone number
 - o Unique DNA Code
 - o 50x Property description Model/Serial numbers, photos, notes etc.

Because the individual owns the SAR they have their own log in details and can update the list at any time.

- Sell an Item Update the SAR
- Item Stolen Update the SAR
- Over 50 items marked the number of items marked will depend on how much liquid used, so if you mark more than the 50 lines of text available, the Synthetic DNA and Microdots will still come back to you.

If something was stolen, imagine how you would describe it to the Police. If you can't describe it accurately, how do you expect the Police to find it? SelectaDNA and the SAR ticks all these boxes.

Police Access to the Secure Asset Register – Police have a separate log-in which will allow access to search on a Microdot code. These Microdots can be read under a microscope and will provide quick and speedy identification of ownership. Every person taken into custody has all their property removed from them. Police will search under UV light to see if items are marked. Similarly, we search people, cars and property on a regular basis, and I'm sure have had to return stolen items to people when ownership can't be established. This gives us a tool to search for and prove ownership.

Wiltshire Police have committed to providing a free kit to victims of residential burglary (includes sheds and outbuildings). This is separate to the NPCC promise to visit all victims of residential burglary (Wiltshire attended 88.7% already) which came out last week

Several studies have shown that a victim of burglary is more likely to become a repeat victim than they were to being burgled in the first place. One national study suggests 1 in 4 will become a repeat victim. Additionally, neighbouring properties also see a rise in burglary offences.

Crime Prevention can happen at any time and can only influence the future.

Wiltshire Police have negotiated a significant discount to Wiltshire Residents who wish to purchase their own SelectaDNA Home Kit for £25 inc. VAT & Delivery (Full price for a Home Kit is £67.84 including VAT and Delivery). This is only available via the Neighbourhood Watch Association link and not via the general website: www.selectadna.co.uk/NHW using code NHWAWILTSHIRE Communities (Parish/Village/Street) where over 40% of homes have registered a kit, can have the additional benefit of supplying of Street Signage to add further deterrent to burglars.

Recycling for Wiltshire Air Ambulance.

As a new initiative there is now a community collection point to support 'Recycle 4 Wiltshire Air Ambulance' at Ebbesbourne Wake pavilion.

'Recycle 4 Wiltshire Air Ambulance' was founded by two volunteers in 2014 and has raised over £90,000 for the Wiltshire Air Ambulance which is funded solely on donations. The scheme involves collecting specific household packaging and waste which would otherwise go to landfill. It is sent to TerraCycle UK who sponsor specific schemes and exchange the hard to recycle waste into donations for the charity.

All items sent TerraCycle are processed in the UK and recycled to make other items. Recycling through TerraCycle is a great way to raise vital funds for the charity and to save waste from landfill.

Current recycling schemes at the pavilion are: -

<u>Confectionery</u> -All brands of chocolate bar wrappers, all brands of chocolate/sweet share size pouches, all brands of chocolate/sweet outer packaging, all brands of sweet packets and wrappers. NO tin foil or cardboard.

Ferrero Rocher - All packaging, tray boxes, plastic sleeves. NO paper and cardboard

Kinder - All kinder packaging

<u>Biscuits/ Cakes and snacks</u> - All brands of non-savoury biscuit wrappers including mini cheddars and twiglets, all brands of cake bar wrappers and all brands of cracker wrappers.

Recycling for Wiltshire Air Ambulance.

<u>Bread bags, pittas, bagels, crumpets, wraps and bakery</u> - All brands of bread bags incl closure tags, bakery plastic packaging, plastic trays, zipper bags, plastic packs, Wax bread wrap

<u>Snacks</u> - Any brand of Peanuts, Popcorn, Crisps, Pretzels, Pork Scratching packaging, any snacks e.g., Skips, Hula Hoops, Wotsits, Popchips, Monster Munch, Doritos, Quavers, Snack a Jacks, Pom Bears, Wheat Crunchies, Sunbites, Lentil Curls, Vegetable Chips etc Pringles - All Pringle tubes, NO supermarket brands, or lids

Cheese packaging - Plastic cheese pouches, individual wrappers, cheese nets, film from sliced cheese trays.

<u>Babybel</u> - Individual Babybel wrappers, babybel metal clasp, babybel labels, babybel nets, babybel mini rolls flexible plastic packaging.

Coffee packaging - All brands of coffee bean and ground coffee pouches, all brands of individual coffee bag sachets.

<u>Lavazza Coffee Eco Caps</u> - All Lavazza Eco caps comparable with Nespresso coffee machines, all Lavazza Eco Caps compatible with Lavazza A Modo Mio coffee machines. NO other pods/ capsules

<u>Home Laundry</u> - Flexible Dishwashing tablet packaging, outer plastic sleeve of tubs, flexible plastic dishwashing salt bags, dishwasher cleaning and freshener outer packaging, flexible home cleaning wipe packaging, flexible stain remover powder packaging, flexible cleaning product refill packaging, fragrance twin pack plastic sleeves, tumble dryer sheets, all brands of tinted fabric conditioner bottles and caps, flexible laundry washing capsules and pod packaging, flexible wipe packaging and tinted rigid plastic tubs used for home cleaning, All brands of plastic air fresheners, cartridge and caps

<u>Reusable plastic drinks bottles and food containers</u> - Reusable plastic drinks bottles and caps, plastic storage containers and lids, including plastic takeaway containers.

NO Single use plastic drinks bottles or food/dips/snack pots.

Marigolds - Marigold gloves only, Marigold packaging

Spontex - Vinyl, Nitrile, Latex & Polyethylene disposable gloves from home use only. NO work/business use gloves

L.O.L Surprise! - L.O.L Surprise! products, packaging, and accessories

Pens - Pens, felt tips, markers, highlighters and correction fluid. NO pencils or Pritt sticks /glue

<u>Oral Dental Care</u> - Any brand of toothbrushes & packaging, any brand of toothpaste & packaging, any brand of electric toothbrush heads, any brand of floss packaging, electric toothbrush heads & covers, electric flosser nozzles, flossing sticks, Interdental brushes, manual toothbrushes. NO wooden toothbrushes or hard plastic pump toothpaste

<u>Makeup and skin care</u> - eye shadow compacts, mascara tubes and wands, lipsticks, lip glosses and lip balms, flexible plastic packaging used for facial wipes, flexible plastic and metallic plastic tubes used for body creams, ointments or moisturisers. NO Glass <u>Luxury skin care Murad and Kate Somerville</u> - Kate Somerville: -droppers, bottles, pumps, caps, tubes, and jars. Murad: -Tubes, caps, bottles pumps, containers, and lids

<u>Garnier & L'Oreal Personal care and Beauty</u> - All brands flexible single use mask packaging including the blue film, cap, pumps, triggers, sprays, flexible wipes packaging, roll on deodorants, empty make up packaging, hair dye kits (No cardboard or rigid plastic) NO Rigid Bottles or Cardboard, ALL BRANDS

<u>Hair Care</u> - Shampoo refill pouches, hair mask pouches, flexible tubes, triggers and pumps. Only brands - Aussie, Head & Shoulders, Herbal essences, Pantene, Bear Fruit

<u>Carex, Imperial Leather & Bayleys of Bond St</u> - Carex, Imperial Leather and Bayley's of Bond St refill pouches, caps and hand wash pumps. NO bottles

<u>Baylis & Harding</u> - Baylis & Harding caps, hand and mist pumps, flexible plastic lotion tubes and caps, Baylis & Harding Goodness hand wash refill pouches- excluding cardboard. NO other brands

If you want to support the scheme start by collecting empty items from the list at home and whenever is convenient take to the pavilion which is always open. At the pavilion, please put items into the labelled boxes. Items do not have to be washed apart from cheese wrappers and food containers. The boxes will be regularly emptied and taken to the main collection hub in Salisbury. 'Recycle 4 Wiltshire Air Ambulance' are grateful for all support so feel free to get your friends and family involved. This is a great scheme for anyone to be able to contribute to supporting the work of the Wiltshire Air Ambulance and recycle waste which would otherwise be put in the bin.
