"ALVEDISTON ALERT".

The Alert Scheme agreed to be established at the recent Parish Meeting is now live. PLEASE DO SIGN UP. THE MORE WHO JOIN THE MORE EFFECTIVE THE SCHEME.

* NOTE: Andrew Boys is the Administrator for the new Alvediston Alert Group and the, already established, Village WhatsApp group. If you are a member of the village group, send a simple message there, "count me in to Alert", and no further action will be needed to sign up.

Our alert scheme outline -

- The scheme's purpose is to provide all members of the scheme with <u>real-time alerts</u> of potential or actual incidents that could or should give rise to a report to the police.
- So that all who sign up can know what is of immediate concern, the scheme's primary reporting will be achieved by any member's notification to the 'one purpose' WhatsApp Group. Reporting will also be available through email or a landline telephone, where confidentiality is wanted or for those without WhatsApp access. The Group Coordinator will filter the reports and notify our dedicated PCSO (NB see "IMPORTANT" below).
- The immediacy of reporting cruising of suspicious vehicles; road blockages; etc through the scheme should aide prevention most incidents reported to the Police are 'after the event'.
- We are promised that we will receive feedback on incidents reported to our PCSO by the Group Coordinator (unlike 101)
- The scheme will be most effective if all Parish residents sign up through WhatsApp, by providing their telephone number to the Group Administrator or their email address to the coordinator. Residents of adjoining Parishes will be welcome to register.
- Reporting: "Don't hold back" but "Information rather than conversation", please.

IMPORTANT

- Our Alert Scheme is intended to be a support system additional to the normal reporting of incidents to the police
- Incidents requiring immediate police action, such as suspected burglaries in progress or accidents, should be reported by 999
- Incidents not requiring immediate action by the police should still be reported through 101 so that the Police centralised data record can have integrity (Note: as it is known that the 101 telephone line can require long waiting times it would probably be better to log an incident through its website: <u>https://www.police.uk/pu/contact-the-police/report-a-crimeincident/</u>).
